**URGENT: CANCELLATION OF PERMISSION TO ALLOW VESSEL M/V KATHRIN
 TO ENTER NAMIBIAN WATERS IN TRANSIT CARGO: PORT OF WALVIS BAY**

I refer to my office letter dated 13 August 2024, with regards to the above subject matter.

Kindly be informed that, the permission no. 21/2024 granted to M/V Kathrin dated 13 August 2024 has been revoked with immediate effect. Your application letter dated 02 August 2024 and all attached document you submitted to this office indicated that M/V Kathrin was coming from Haiphong, Vietnam (Port of loading) to Koper, Slovenia (Port of discharge), carrying explosives cargo of sixty (60) containers of Tri-Nitro Toluene (TNT) and eight (8) containers of Hexogen Explosives, however, the extra document you submitted today, 24 August 2024, shows that, one of the consignment (RDX Hexogen Explosives) is destined for Israel. Hence, the said vessel is strictly prohibited to enter the Namibian Waters in terms of the Cabinet decision No. 9th/04.06.24/006.
